PARKING AT FRUITVALE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Parents of children attending Fruitvale Elementary School are reminded that children should be dropped off and picked up at the bottom of the stairs on Beaver Street, just past the lower field or at the footbridge area along Laurier Avenue.

Parents and caregivers should not be parking along Columbia Gardens Road or on private property to drop off or pick up children. Also, there is a sidewalk on Columbia Gardens Road that should not be parked on and there are yellow 'no parking' lines that need to be observed.

Parents, caregivers and residents of Beaver Street East are also reminded of the sidewalk along Beaver Street from the intersection of Columbia Gardens Road to Laurier Avenue. Please do not park vehicles on the sidewalk as it puts pedestrians in danger when they have to walk around the vehicles and onto the road.
