






VILLAGE OF FRUITVALE PROPERTY TAX SALE

The Village of Fruitvale's 2024 Tax Sale is scheduled for 10:00 am sharp on Monday, October 7, 2024, at the Village of Fruitvale Office.

Letters have been sent to those property owners in a tax sale situation. If your property taxes are in delinquent status (three years of unpaid taxes - 2022, 2023 and 2024) you must pay the delinquent (2022) taxes before 9:59 am October 7, 2024, to keep your property from being sold at the tax sale.

A listing of tax sale properties will appear in the September 26 and October 3 editions of the Trail Times. To keep your property from appearing in the newspaper advertisements, the delinquent taxes must be paid in full prior to September 23, 2024.
