

JOB OPPORTUNITY VILLAGE OF FRUITVALE SUMMER STUDENT GARDENER

The Village of Fruitvale is seeking **two (2)** enthusiastic, energetic, and self-motivated people to fill the positions, each of which are entitled **SUMMER STUDENT GARDENER.** The expected start date is the week of May 20, 2025 and is to run twelve(12) weeks at thirty (35) hours/week.

Reporting to the Public Works Foreman, the successful candidates will be required to perform special assignment duties, including, but not limited to, downtown beautification, gardening and weed control, and other projects. Assignments are performed under general supervision and performance is subject to review and evaluation.

To be eligible for consideration you be a high school graduate or college or university student who is registered or have declared their intention of returning to a bona fide college or university. They must be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the "Immigration and Refugee Protection Act [S.C. 2001, c. 27]*" be legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/ territorial legislation and regulations.

Summer employees are entitled to statutory benefits as defined in the Employment Standards Act. They do not accumulate seniority. The wage for each position will be \$22.85 based on a 35-hour week.
